



MATURITY LEVEL RATING







OVERALL MATURITY LEVEL SEGMENTATION

ADDRESSING BARRIERS

Awareness

The Task Force on PSI and Open Data of the Federal Ministry for Digital and Economic Affairs - together with the Cooperation OGD Austria - has boosted available information on necessary adaptations with regard to implementing Directive 2019/1024 (Directive on open data and the re-use of public sector information). Regular meetings with public sector bodies and stakeholders are taking place and presentations and courses on Open Data and PSI have been organized.

Technical

Better information and manuals on how to publish data have been elaborated. Communication via social media has been intensified, also with regard to the COVID-19 crisis and illustrating the importance of data. An interesting effect is the willingness of science and society in general to offer support for improving the interoperability of any kind of data (e.g. COVID-19 statistics). Continuous dialogue with public sector bodies on technical requirements and improvements is taking place.



OPEN DATA RE-USE

The Austrian [national open data portal](#) provides a designated area to showcase open data re-use. Currently, the page shows already 598 applications that have been developed using open data.

When clicking on an application, the visitor does not only receive information about the application itself, but also information about what open datasets are used to develop the application and a direct link to these datasets. Additional information is also displayed, such as the release date, the systems on which the application runs, the type of application (website, visualization tool, mobile app, etc.) and contact details of the owner of the application.

An example of open data re-use is the [48er application](#). It provides the most important information on the disposal of waste in Vienna. The application combines various datasets from the City of Vienna, such as: christmas tree collection points, mobile collection points for hazardous substances, and used material collection points.
