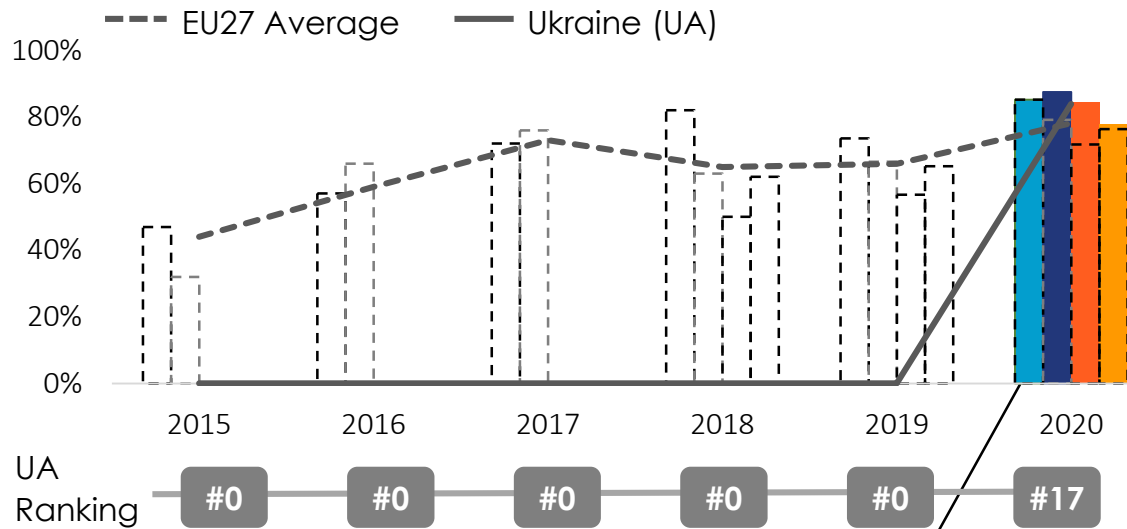

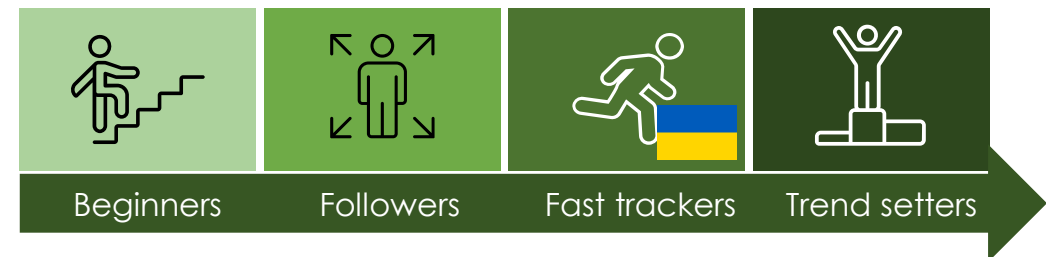
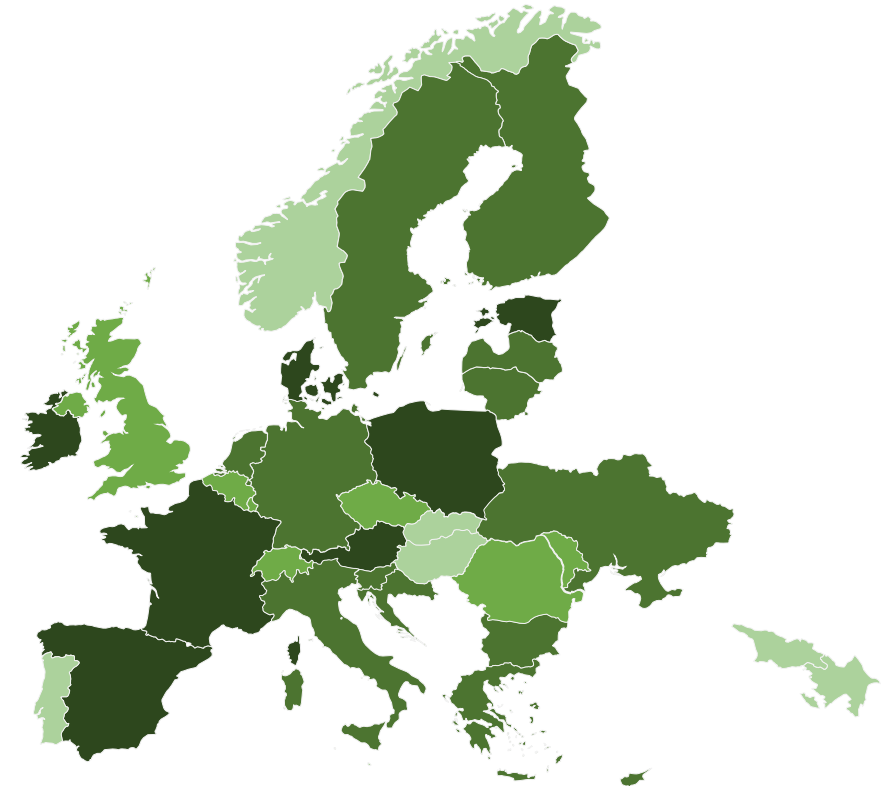

OVERALL MATURITY LEVEL SEGMENTATION

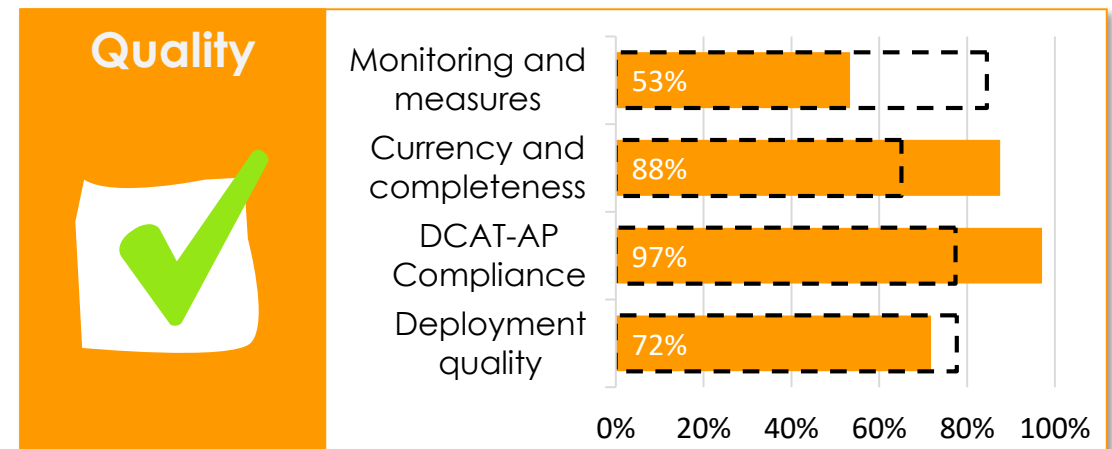
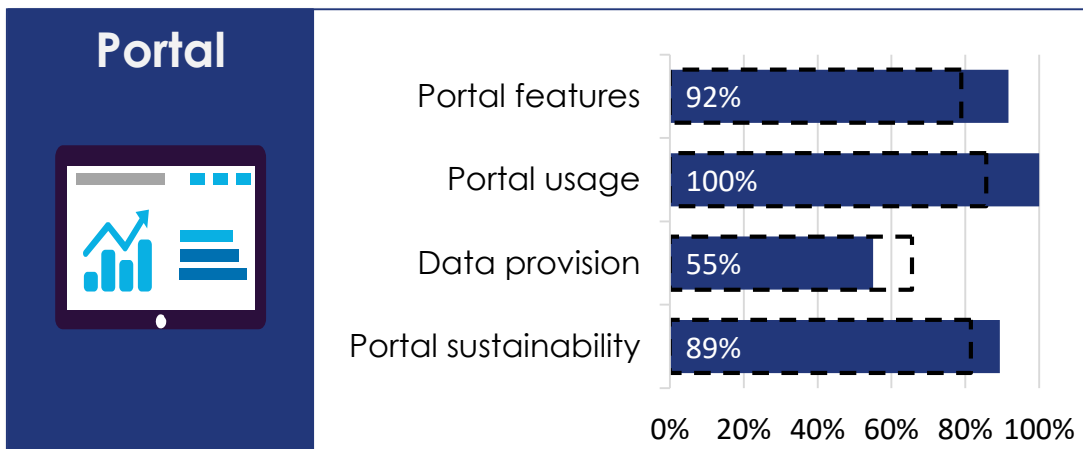
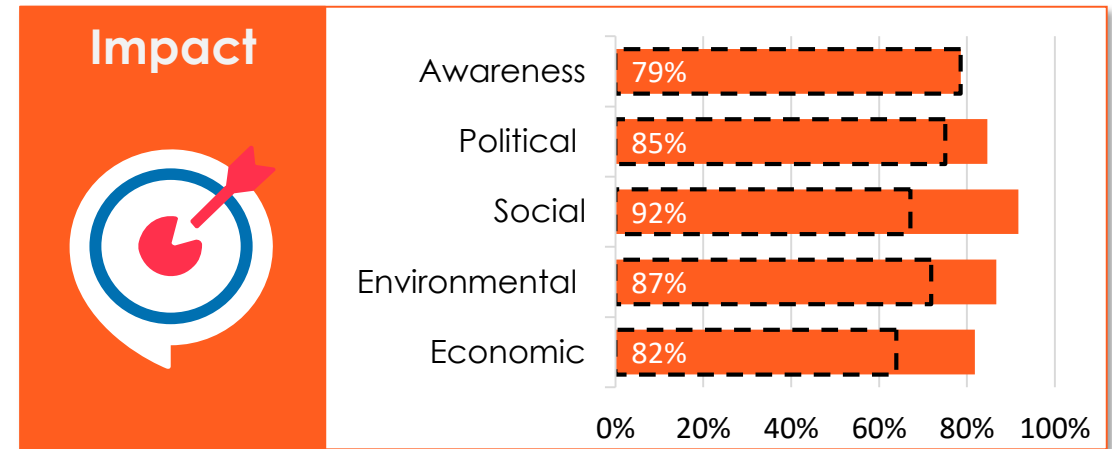
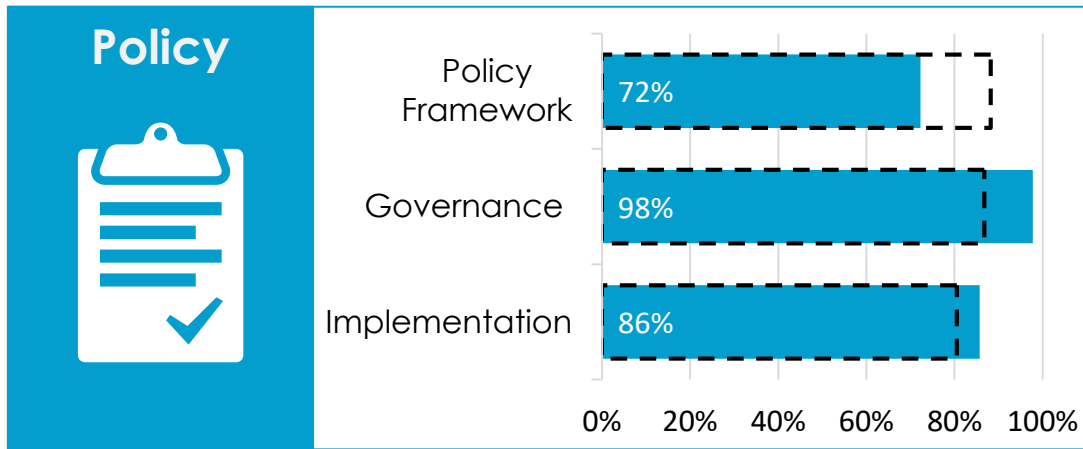

ADDRESSING BARRIERS



Governance

Some public bodies refused to publish data as it was not listed in Decree 835 - which dictates which datasets have to be open. Therefore, Decree 835 was updated, and the list of additional datasets were included which had a positive impact on the opening of some datasets .



Legal

Some of IT systems in public bodies are outdated and there is no financial investment to deploy new ones. Therefore, the Ministry of the Digital Transformation attracted donor funding and IT solutions in some public bodies were introduced.



Technical

Previous governance model did not have the role of Chief Digital Transformation Officer which created additional challenges in opening high-value datasets. Therefore, a new governance is introduced with a key role for Chief Digital Transformation Officers



OPEN DATA RE-USE

The national open data portal of Ukraine provides a designated area for [open data use cases](#) to provide further insight and inspiration into how open data can be used to create services, applications, and products. Currently, the page shows 50 open data re-use cases.

When clicking on an application, the visitor does not only receive information about the application itself, but also information about what open datasets are used to develop the application and a direct link to these datasets.

An example of open data re-use in Ukraine is an education dashboard. The Ministry of Finance used open data for the creation the [interactive dashboard](#) that allows to see the expenditures for general secondary education, both in the country as a whole and in individual areas, or even in individual schools.
