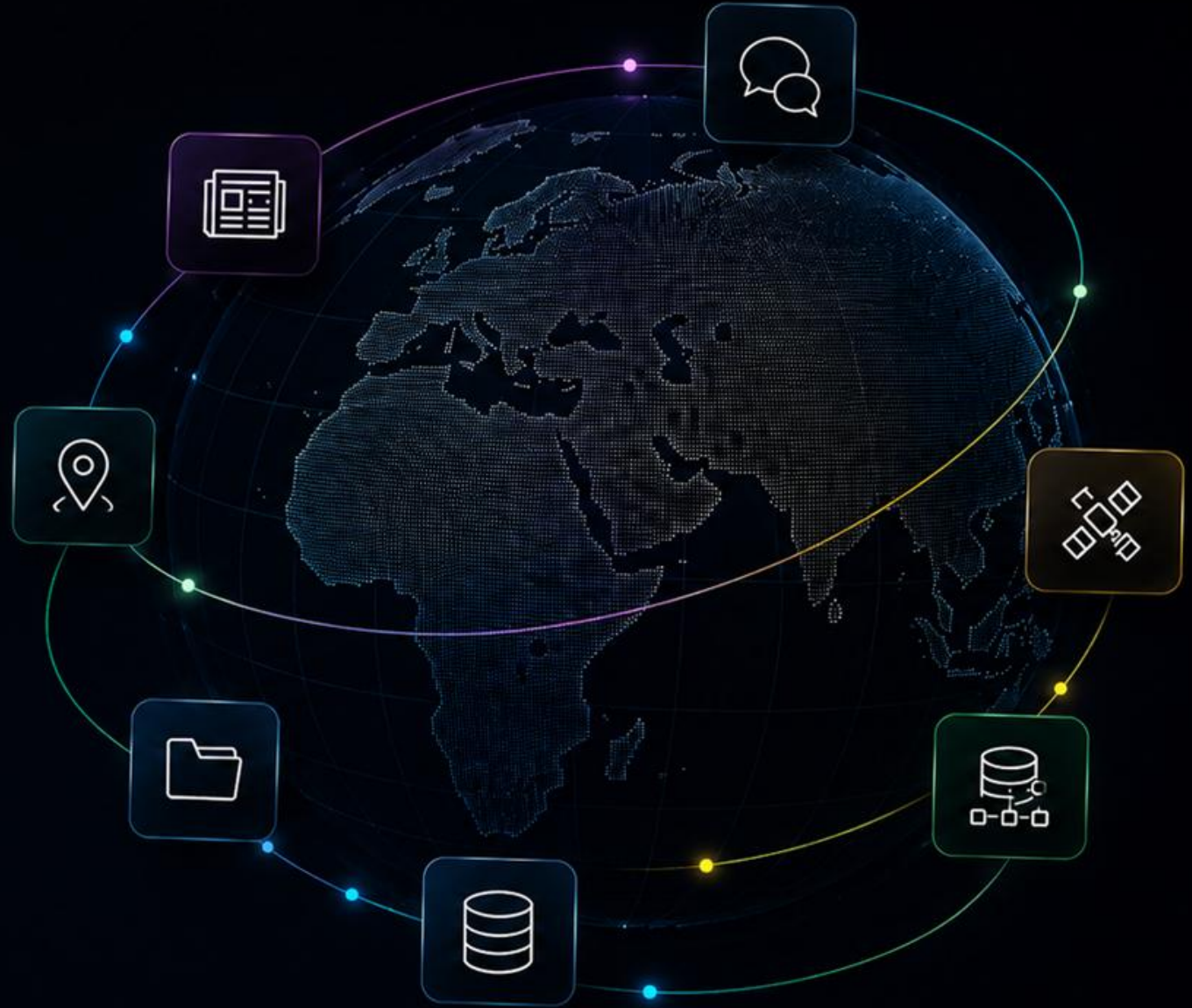

Main Approaches to Public Information Protection



→ Legally permitted publication of non-sensitive data for specific companies (e.g., postal addresses)



→ Data filtration for specific companies



→ Restriction of access to specific attributes for all companies

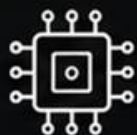

Lessons learned



Balance

Restrictions on sensitive information must be proportionate and time-limited, based on security risks.



Mechanism

A transparent process for imposing and lifting restrictions is essential.



Protection

Extremely sensitive information should remain confidential.



Infrastructure

Systems must support data classification and publication.



Cooperation

Cross-sector cooperation strengthens open data governance.

Quality

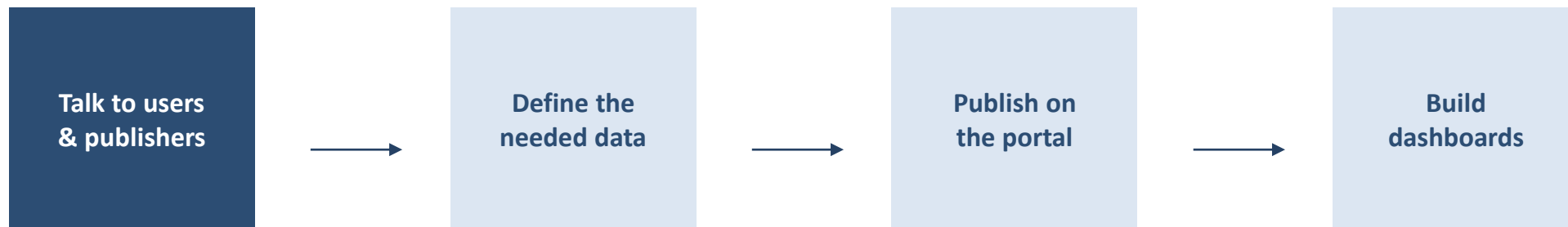
Relevance

A problem-first approach to open data reuse.

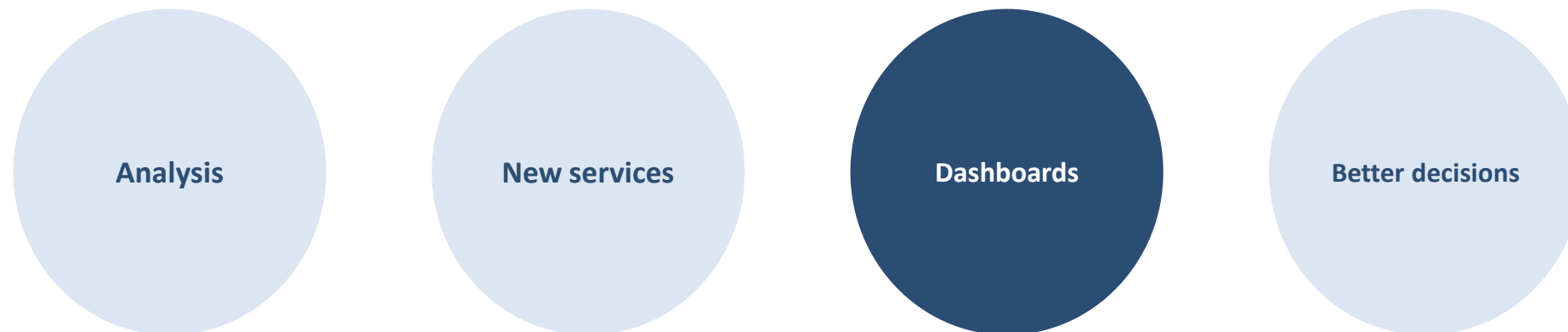


Problem-first. Demand-driven. Reuse-oriented.

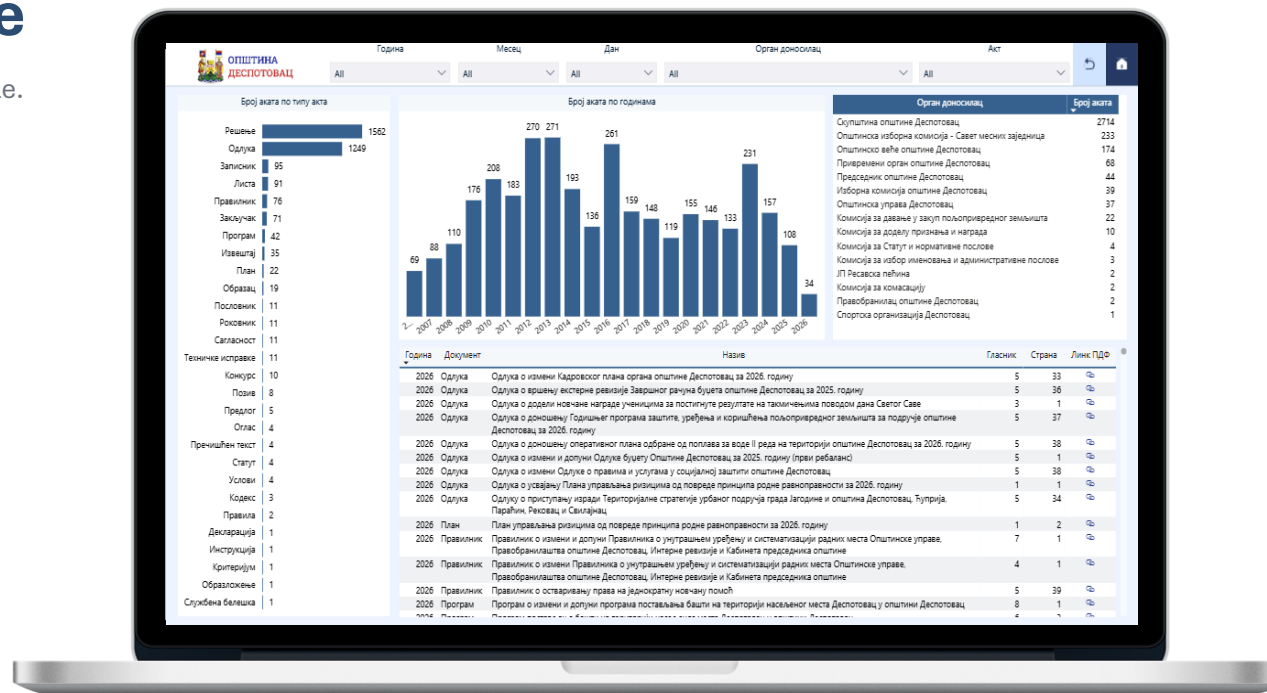
