The City of Nantes has accepted to offer to host the European communities and provide funds which will be 100 % allocated to trips, accommodation and catering to host the event. Co-working spaces and conference rooms will be available through our partnerships with the <u>La</u> <u>Cantine coworking space</u> and European networks that will join.

During the event, participants will brainstorm different means to create a European community, suggest actions for the E.U and create tools to foster community building.
