The [Aragón Open Data Jacathon](#) will take place on the 26th and 27th of September 2014, at the Ice Pavilion in the City of Jaca. (Note: 'Hacka' in English and 'Jaca' in Spanish are pronounced the same, hence the idea for the 'Jacathon' brand).



It is an event that promotes data opening, designed for participants to collaborate/compete in app development. The event is aimed at developers and other data related professionals, with all [members of the ePSI platform](#) invited to get involved!

The Jacathon will have two main parts. The first being a dissemination session, and the second being the 24 hour competition. The full schedule and other information relating to the event is available on the [Jacathon website](#) (only in Spanish). Remember also to read the [contest rules](#).

Three awards will be handed out at the end of the event, recognising the best computer/app developments or stories made at the Jacathon in relation to AragoPedia/AragoDBPedia, Aragón Open Social Data, and Aragón Open Data Catalogue. The winning team in each category will receive a prize of 3,000 EUR.

- Meals that will be served during the development competition and final dinner
- Doc that could be given to the competitor
- Jacathon T-shirt
- Zaragoza University certification of participation at the event
