Description

The Deutsche Interdisziplinäre Vereinigung für Intensiv- und Notfallmedizin (DIVI) created an online intensive care register that is updated on a daily basis. On their website, registered users can see the availability of intensive care beds, with and without invasive ventilation possibilities, for all the German hospitals and clinics. Furthermore, the website includes visualisations and recommendations to inform people on the COVID-19 crisis.

How open data is used

Every intensive care unit in each reporting area of a hospital location makes a report at least once a day in order to fulfill its reporting obligation. A weekly report for the past calendar week is available for download. This proof can be forwarded to the responsible district or country office by email.
