As of August 2020, the Netherlands is the first country in the world to create a digital overview of all national road signs. This development was commissioned by the Ministry of Infrastructure and Water Management. Data has been collected by HR Groep and will be made openly available using the Nationale Databank Wegverkeersgegevens.
