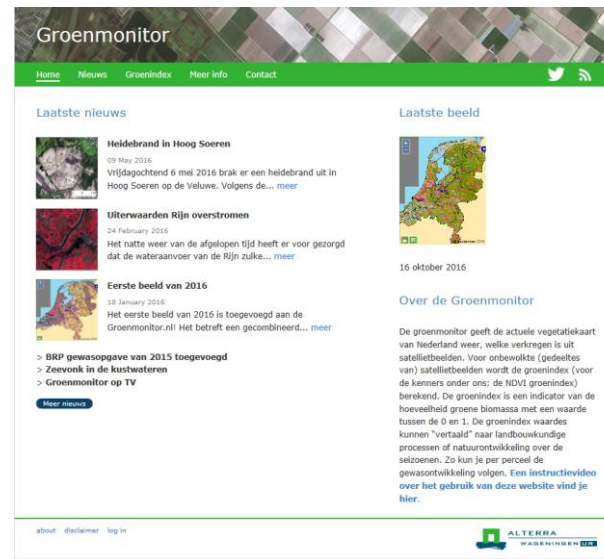
Benefits

-  Groenmonitor (Green monitor) monitors how green the Netherlands is by using satellite images.




How Open Data is used

-  Groenmonitor displays the current Dutch vegetation map and follows crop development per parcel by calculating the green index through the use of satellite images.
