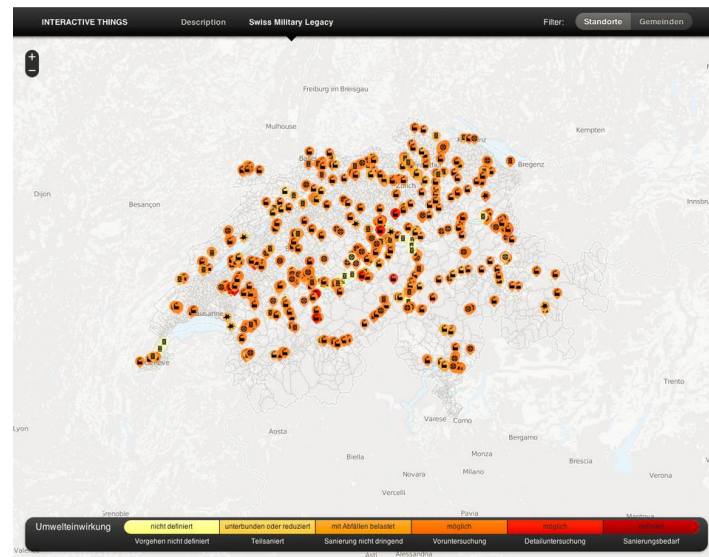
## Benefits

-  The contamination of the ground by heavy metals, wild landfills, residues of flamethrowers and lick tank farms endanger groundwater.
-  The Secretariat of the defense department (VBS) introduces a "register of polluted sites" listing 1500 problematic locations.
